

2013 National Criminal History Improvement Program (NCHIP) Project Funding

Very soon the Department of Justice Bureau of Justice Statistics (BJS) is expected to announce the 2013 National Criminal History Improvement Program (NCHIP) solicitation. There is typically a very tight time frame between the announcement of the grant and the application submittal deadline, so we encourage you to begin development of your project proposal if you anticipate submitting a request.

Federal funding for these projects was once again reduced so it is critical that all proposals support the NCHIP priorities and the Arizona Records Improvement Strategy (click here to view <http://www.azcjc.gov/ACJC.Web/cjrip/AZICJIS.aspx>).

Be sure to consider

A. How you will measure your project's performance (the FY12 solicitation examples are attached for your review),

B. How you will accommodate a 10% match and

C. Your project timeline (award period is 1 year).

More specific proposal requirements will be sent once we receive the federal announcement.
