RECOMMENDATION:

The Commission approve redirecting supplemental FY13 JAG funds to a White Mountain Apache Tribal detention construction project.

DISCUSSION:

The White Mountain Apache tribe was granted \$1 million in 2009 under an ARRA grant for completion of a juvenile/adult detention center. In 2013 an updated construction estimate revealed the costs had gone up by \$50,000 and the project was now in danger of not being started/completed. If not started/completed, the \$1 million in funding would have to be returned to BJA. The \$50,000 would be used to begin and complete the project. The project cannot be started until BJA has assurances that the construction will meet requirements of the grant.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$50,000 reduction to ACJC Byrne/JAG allocation for FY13. \$50,000 to White Mountain Apache Tribe to use to start and complete a \$1 million construction project; if not, started/completed the tribe risks losing the \$1 million federal grant.
